**First come, first served until funds are expended.**

### **PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS**

- Cost Share: **Up to 50% of actual cost or \$1,000 (whichever is less)**
- Improve water quantity/quality in Wallace County
- Easy application process for cost share consideration

### **ELIGIBLE PRACTICES**

- Water testing
- Water saving shower head
- Hose timer
- Water leak detector
- Leak detection system
- Rain barrels
- Reverse osmosis system
- Xeriscaping
- Conversion from blue grass to buffalo grass
- Installation of underground sprinkler system (residential)
- Moisture sensing device for underground sprinklers (residential)
- Drilling domestic water well

### **HOW TO APPLY**

- Complete the application form available at the Conservation Office
- Attach your receipt and a photo of the installed practice
- Include documentation of the water-saving feature
