For the period August 25 – August 31, 2012

**General Interest:** County rainfall averages for August

County precipitation averages for August indicate a modest but very positive change in precipitation for some counties in the target area. The last time a precipitation surplus was recorded in the target area was for the month of April when every target area county reported a surplus. For August, Scott and Lane reported a surplus with the reports from Lane showing a very significant surplus! Rain reports from the Community Collaborative Rain, Hail and Snow Network (CoCoRaHS), <a href="www.cocorahs.org">www.cocorahs.org</a>, indicate the highest 2012 August county precipitation average was in Lane County with 4.13 inches or 51% above normal for Lane. Following Lane, Scott County reported 3.30 inches (26% above normal for Scott). The remaining counties experienced little to no reprieve from the devastating drought with Kearny County reporting 1.26 inches (54% below), Wichita County recording 1.17 inches (55% below), and Hamilton County with 1.06 inches (55% below).

<u>Weather:</u> Tranquil conditions prevailed the entire week with mostly sunny skies, clear nights and daytime highs in the 90's.

**Operations:** No operations this week.
