- I. CALL MEETING TO ORDER President, Mark Callender called the January 19, 2024, Board of Directors meeting of the Western Kansas Groundwater Management District No.1 to order at 8:03 a.m., located at the District Office in Scott City, Kansas.
- ✓ Noted Changes to the January 19, 2024 Agenda: Katie Durham added the Board Members Mileage Report to the Agenda.
- ✓ <u>Noted Changes to the December 20, 2023 Board Meeting Minutes:</u> Mark Callender suggested placing the changes to the Agenda and Minutes under "Call Meeting to Order" for future Board Meeting Minutes. The Board agreed,
- a) Review & Approve Agenda The Board reviewed the January 19, 2024 Agenda. Travis Weaver made a motion to approve the Agenda with the addition noted above. Brian Bauck seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
- b) Review & Approve Minutes of the December 20, 2023 Board Meeting The Board reviewed the December 20, 2023 minutes. Steve Compton made a motion to approve the minutes with the changes noted above. Ray Smith seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
- c) Review & Approve December 2023 Financials Katie Durham referred the Board to the December 2023 year end financials and stated that those would be part of her Annual Report to the Legislator Committee. Rene Cure, the District's CPA was conferenced into the meeting after Ray Smith asked for clarification on the financials. Renee concurred that the financials were correct and explained the figures that were in question. Ray Smith made a motion to approve the December 2023 financials. Steve Compton seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

#### II. CORRESPONDENCES:

- a) Staff Report:
  - -Board Calendar Katie Durham referred the Board to the GMD1 2023/2024 scheduling updates in the Board packet and pointed out upcoming meeting dates. Ray Smith and Mark Callender stated that they would like to attend the Ogallala Summit Conference March 18-19, 2024 in Liberal Kansas.
  - -<u>Grant Updates and Recommendation Letters</u> Representative Jim Minix reported on the grant updates that have been completed and successful. Katie stated that there were five grants requested from the GMD1 District service area that she has provided recommendations letters for.
  - -Soil Health and U Conference Katie Durham stated that she was invited to be on the panel for the Soil Health and U Conference in Salina, KS. on January 17-18, 2024. Katie reported there was a lot of focus on regenerative soil work, cover crops, incentives towards water conservation, and discussions on the LEMA's.
  - -Water use report Katie Durham reported that the water use reports are starting to come into the office as well as verified claims.

-Katie discussed with the Board the possibility of building a little flexibility into the future LEMA'S and the process that it would have to go through. In addition, Katie Durham discussed House Bill 2634 which has been proposed by GMD1 and GMD4 to change the law, in order to allow producers to have enhanced flexibility within existing LEMA's or IGUCA's.

#### III. OLD BUSINESS:

- a) 2024 Annual Meeting Katie Durham reminded the Board that the Annual Meeting is on February 28, 2024, and that Tallee Davis with Northwest Tech will be funding the lunch with grant funds. Webb BBQ will be catering the meal. Katie stated that Brownie Wilson from KGS will not be able to attend the meeting but will have a prerecorded slide show available. Speakers for the Annual Meeting will include Sheridan 6/GMD4 producers that will share their experiences with the LEMA, Jack Polika with Northwest Tech who is an Irrigation technician at the Precision Agriculture Program there at the college. Katie explained that she and Tom Adrian have been working on the Annual Meeting notice that will go out next Friday and will have detailed bullets about the voting criteria and the Board positions that are up for reelection for Lane County and Wichita County.
- b) <u>GRASP/PLJV Position</u> Katie Durham stated that she and Mark Callender were able to sit in on the interviews for the PLJV position with Matt Smith. Katie informed the Board that Titus Jaeger from Lakin, Kansas was hired for the position and referred the Board to the spreadsheet on page 16 of the Board Packet that outlines his job duties.
- c) Wichita County LEMA Discussion Outreach & Annual Report Katie Durham reported on the data for the Wichita County LEMA that will be submitted to the Legislative session on January 23rd in Topeka, Kansas and to the annual meeting on February 28th. David Barfield elaborated on some of the changes that were made to the WC LEMA Annual Report. The Board suggested a few more changes which David will finalize for their review next month. Lastly, David presented the database that they are working on for producers to be able to look up the water usage and LEMA allocations. Katie reminded the Board of the upcoming Outreach Meetings in March.
- d) <u>January 24<sup>th</sup> Annual Report Deadline and Legislative Visit</u> Katie Durham went over the Annual Report that she will present to the Legislative Session on January 24, 2024. Steve Compton made a motion to approve 2023 Annual Report to the Legislative Session. Ray Smith seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
- e) Rules & Regulation Discussion Katie referred the Board's attention to the draft of the WCA Regulations in the Board packet. Katie specifically explains the changes in the point of diversion of groundwater rights. Mike Meyer added an additional breakdown explanation and stated that any concerns or comments from the Board will be taken into consideration until February 9, 2024. After Board discussion, Mike Meyer and David Barfield voiced their concerns regarding the changes, the Board agreed to have Katie write a letter regarding the concerns and email to the Board for review before sending it to DWR by February 9th. Steve Compton made a motion to approve a letter of concern regarding the changes in points of diversion once the Board has reviewed the letter by email. Ray Smith seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

#### IV. NEW BUSINESS:

- a) Cost Share Reconciliation Katie Durham presented the Cost Share Reconciliation report ending 12/31/23 to the Board. The Board discussed the report and had Katie clarify questions that they had regarding the report. Travis Weaver made a motion to approve the Cost Share report. Steve Compton seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
- b) <u>Gap Resolution</u> Katie Durham mentioned that the Gap Resolution for 2024 needs Board approval. This Gap Resolution would be combined with our Audit that Mathew Medill, CPA, CFE Partner Medill and Thooft, CPA would receive a copy of. Ray Smith made a motion to approve the 2024 Gap Resolution. Brian Bauck seconded the motion which was passed unanimously.
- a) Wichita County Combine Well Unit Application Brian Bauck explained his request to combine 2 wells that are no longer in the Wichita County WCA. Mike Meyer offered an additional explanation of the unforeseen circumstances of his application, sharing his concerns about both wells that are no longer in the WCA, but still under the WC LEMA. The Board had a lengthy discussion with Katie Durham, Mike Meyer, Tom Adrian, and David Barfield regarding the circumstances. The Board suggested having Tom and Katie write a request to the Chief Engineer in pursuing a possible waiver regarding the application and to also file a term permit if needed. Travis Weaver made a motion to have Katie and Tom draw up a request letter to the Chief Engineer, and to file a term permit depending on the response of the Chief Engineer. Steve Compton seconded the motion which passed unanimously. Brian Bauck abstained himself from the vote.
- b) 9:00 am Zoom with Vijay Ramasamy Vijay Ramasamy reported on the Governor's budget recommendations and gave a breakdown on how much money was budgeted for specific initiatives for water conservation that will take effect in the fiscal year of 2025.

#### V. K-STATE UPDATE -- NONE

- VI. <u>DWR REPORT</u> Mike Meyer reported that DWR and KGS were able to get the wells measured. Mike shared that Brownie Wilson's preliminary results from measuring wells was that for the GMD1 counties the aquifer has done a rebound, stating that on average the water levels were up by 2-3 inches. He also states the water use reports are still coming in along with meter repair forms and DWR is still down for 2 positions.
- VII. KWO REPORT Keadron Pearson reported on the Water Authority and the Rac meetings that were held.

- VIII. PUBLIC COMMENT Don Smith shared thoughts regarding the potential renewal of the WC LEMA and brought forth some ideas regarding how the data is processed moving forward and noted that some additional flexibility in a future WC LEMA would be greatly appreciated.
- IX. <u>BOARD MILEAGE</u> Mileage reports for the year ending 2023 were provided to the Board Members to sign if they agreed with the totals. No discrepancies were reported.
- X. <u>MEETING ADJOURN</u> Ray Smith made a motion to adjourn the Board meeting at 11:24 a.m. Travis Weaver seconded the motion which passed unanimously. Next meeting will be on February 28<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 a.m. at the Child Advocacy Center followed by the Annual Meeting which starts at 12:00 p.m.
